## RESOLUTION OF THE MANTUA TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH NEIL BULLUCK OF NB CONTROLS, INC.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, upon proper motion and vote at a public meeting of the Mantua Township Municipal Utilities Authority, as follows:

- 1. Neil Bulluck of NB Controls, Inc. is hereby appointed Control Systems Contractor for a period of one year commencing February 2, 2021 until Reorganization, 2022.
- 2. The Authority's Chairperson and/or Executive Director are authorized to enter into an agreement on behalf of the Authority with Neil Bulluck for Control Systems services.
- 3. The award is subject to a determination that there are sufficient funds in the Authority's Budget for the Agreement.
- 4. The appointment and contract is awarded pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-1 *et. seq.*
- 5. Notice of this Resolution shall be published in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5 (1)(a)(i).
